SUBJECT: ELECTRICAL INSPECTIONS

POLICY:

WHEREAS, The Board of Trustees of Plateau Electric Cooperative recognizes the responsibility of the Cooperative to provide electric service to all classes of consumers of electric energy, and

WHEREAS, The Board of Trustees also recognizes the degree of care and diligence required in affording the maximum safety and protection for both the Customer and the Cooperative.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That it shall be the policy of the Plateau Electric Cooperative to require an inspection by an electrical inspector, of all electrical services whether classified as <u>permanent</u> or <u>temporary</u>. (The Cooperative will require an inspection with certificate of approval.) An inspector may be anyone who has been selected and approved by the State of Tennessee, The Department of Insurance, Division of Fire Prevention, Nashville, Tennessee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that it shall be the policy of the Plateau Electric Cooperative to require a roughin inspection by an electrical inspector during the construction phase of all new residential buildings.
